



Advantages of studying Medicine at AMA-ZSMU Medical campus



in Poland:

The Zaporizhzhia State Medical University (ZSMU) has about 120 years of track record as a major European Medical University. (Students from over 40 countries are studying at the Zaporizhzhia Medical University and India alone has over 1,500 students - studying for the 2nd to the 6th-year medical program (this is the pre-war situation).

MD program graduates have the opportunity to take US medical license & work in the USA or can take a license & work in any EU country, including the UK or anywhere in the world.

US and EU Integrated MD curriculum:

MD academic programs are offered in English by European and US professors, also with visiting international distinguished medical faculties. Clinical practice will be done at Polish hospitals and we offer other options.

Options are available to do clinical at other EU country hospitals and US teaching hospitals (certain conditions would apply).

How long does it take to become a physician in Poland through AMA-ZSMU Medical Campus?

It takes 6 - years to complete the ZSMU's MD degree in Poland.

[The ZSMU's 6-year MD program in Poland, which runs from October to June, is specially designed for secondary school graduates. The first 6 semesters of pre-clinical education cover the basics of biology, medical chemistry, anatomy, biophysics, histology, and cell biology, to name a few.

The last 3 years are devoted to clinical education, with emphasis on the fields of internal medicine, surgery, obstetrics & gynecology, pediatrics, and family medicine, among many others.]

What are the requirements for studying at AMA-ZSMU Polish Medical Campus?

[The basic requirement is a high school diploma/12th-grade completion, compared to other countries, AMA-ZSMU Polish medical Campus favors their competency tests over medical University admission tests.]

AMA-ZSMU medical campus using modern educational technologies.

All students will receive a free laptop with State-of-the-Art educational software to study, take exams and do training, and more; also available e-medical library facilities during the study period.

USMLE PREP COURSES - Students will receive training from the US professors during the 4th & 6th year's program; also available advanced 4 months of optional USMLE training in the USA (some conditions would apply for the US training).

Indian students "1st to 6th years" have the option to do 4 weeks of clinical observation with some major Indian hospitals during summer break with no additional fee.

Note: AMA-ZSMU Indian medical students have the optional 6 months of MCI to face the Eligibility/ PG NEET exam conducted by NMC (MCI) licensing exam training at a major coaching center in India, for those candidates wishing to take an Indian license and practice in India.

Worldwide Degree Recognition: Medical graduates can work in EU countries, the U.S.A., the UK, Australia, India, and worldwide. [Degrees obtained from the ZSMU are accepted worldwide and this includes all European Union countries, Canada, the U.S.A., India, Australia, the UK, and other parts of the world. The Zaporizhzhia State Medical University (ZSMU) is listed in the World Directory of Medical Schools and graduates are eligible to apply for Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) certification.] Due to these opportunities, ZSMU medical graduates are entitled to practice in their destinations of choice.

MD Program Tuition Fee: US\$10,950 per year.

Student Hostel/ dormitory: Available for students, male and female hostel facilities are separate and Indian food is also available. [Candidates can choose individual or shared accommodation as per her/his choice].

All participants are required to pay hostel fees separately to the hostel administration.

Note: All AMA-ZSMU Polish Medical Campus students have the opportunity to visit three of the 13 countries listed above (each candidate can participate total three times during the six years study period), with no additional tuition/training fee. The teaching hospital and country selection will depend upon the availability of the teaching hospital at the time & convenience of the faculty member, etc. Also, AMA-ZSMU Medical Campus students in Poland do NOT require any special visa to travel to any one of these countries (these are EU countries), for going with the faculty member for the study tour program. All AMA-ZSMU medical students will have the opportunity to visit at least three countries from the list during the 2nd year to 6th year program. [Participating students are required to take care of the travel, lodging and food expenses during the study tour program, for any of these countries].

Note. For traveling to these three countries (the USA, Canada, and the UK), participating candidates require a visa, and particularly for the USA & Canada, candidates have to go through the US/Canadian visiting visa process and also will have some additional expenses, besides the travel, lodging, and food expenses, for attending the study tour program with the faculty member/s.

Benefits of Attending the study tour program with AMA-ZSMU faculty Member/s:

The study tour will allow the candidates to gain the experience and knowledge about the visiting country's healthcare system and medical treatment methods and patient evaluation, etc.

[Participants will visit teaching hospitals, clinics, attend seminars, and get exposure to the advanced & latest research methods, etc.

Also, candidates get the opportunity to go sightseeing and visiting historical, cultural, and touristic attractive locations on the side during the free time and would make the cross-country study trip educational, professionally valuable, memorable & fun experience).

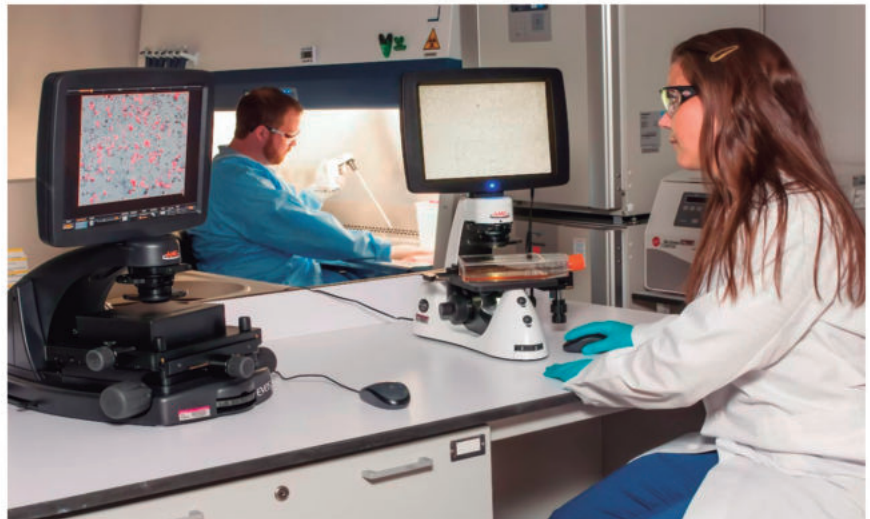

It lies in Lesser Poland, approximately 16 km (10 mi) southwest of the regional capital Rzeszów. The village has a population of 2,900, and has a rail station on the secondary-importance line from Rzeszów to Jasło. Czudec has very good public transport communication with Rzeszow and other cities.

Includes a canteen for students

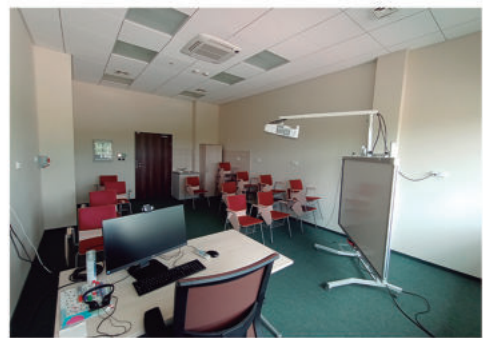




Stalowa Wola medical campus

Information about the region

Subcarpathian Voivodship

Subcarpathian region (Województwo podkarpackie) is located in southeastern Poland. The territory of Subcarpathian region consists of 21 counties (districts) and 4 cities with the rights of the county. Rzeszów is the administrative centre of the region. Almost half of Subcarpathian region territory is covered with forests that are located within protected areas on the state or local levels.

That is the main reason of air pollution in Subcarpathian region being one of the lowest in Poland. This therefore creates favorable conditions for recreation of people with respiratory diseases, as well as for the development of health resort tourism.

The region is one of the safest in Poland, the centre of Rzeszow can easily be explored on foot. You can also rent a bike from one of the bike stands, since the city has a pretty well developed bike path system. There are regular bus services operating to the newer part of town and the suburbs.

Rzeszów–Jasionka Airport (RZE/EPRZ) is an international airport located in a village ten kilometres (6.2 mi) from the center of the city of Rzeszów. It is the eighth-busiest airport in Poland.

The capital of Podkarpackie Province has nearly 220 thousand inhabitants. In terms of number of students Rzeszow places first in the European Union (for every 1000 inhabitants there are 353 students). The average age of the inhabitants of the city is 39, so Rzeszow is often called the city of the young. Rzeszow is a place highly valued by its residents in terms of quality of life. They openly acknowledge that it is a clean, safe, convenient city, which provides life-time stability and satisfaction coming from personal and professional development. Rzeszow is a place of numerous festivals and cultural events.



BRIEF INFORMATION ABOUT POLAND for potential students

Poland, officially the Republic of Poland, is a country in Central Europe. It is divided into 16 administrative provinces called voivodeships. Poland has a population of 38 million and is the fifth-most populous member state of the European Union.

Capital. Warsaw is a major cultural, political, and economic hub, and the country's seat of government. Warsaw is the nation's capital and largest metropolis, the leading economic and financial hub of Central Europe. Other major cities include Kraków, Wrocław, Łódź, Poznań, Gdańsk, and Szczecin.

Climate. Poland is characterized by warm summers, with a mean temperature of around 20 °C (68.0 °F) in July, and moderately cold winters averaging -1 °C (30.2 °F) in December.

Neighbors. The country is bordered by Lithuania and Russia to the northeast, Belarus and Ukraine to the east, Slovakia and the Czech Republic to the south, and Germany to the west. It also shares maritime boundaries with Denmark and Sweden.

Economy and political structure. Poland is a parliamentary republic, with its bicameral legislature comprising the Sejm and the Senate.

It is a developed market and a high-income. Considered a middle power, Poland has the sixth largest economy in the European Union. The largest component of Poland's economy is the service sector (62.3%), followed by industry (34.2%) and agriculture (3.5%). It provides high standards of living, safety, and economic freedom, as well as free university education and a universal health care system. Poland is a founding member state of the United Nations, as well as a member of the World Trade Organization, NATO, and the European Union (including the Schengen Area).

Currency. While Poland joined the European Union in 2004, the country doesn't use the Euro. Instead, Poland continues to use its own national currency, the złoty, which dates right back to the 14th century. ATM machines are everywhere and most accepting all major credit and debit card types.

Architecture. The country has 17 UNESCO World Heritage Sites, 15 of which are cultural. The architecture of Poland reflects European architectural styles, with strong historical influences derived from Italy, Germany, and the Low Countries.

Transport. The country is part of the EU's Schengen Area and is an important transport hub along neighboring Germany due to its strategic position in Central Europe. Poland has several international airports, the largest of which is Warsaw Chopin Airport, with a distance of 330 km from Rzeszow City.

Language. Polish is the official and predominant spoken language in Poland, and is one of the official languages of the European Union. Around 32% of Polish citizens declared knowledge of the English.

Religion. 87.6% of all Polish citizens adhere to the Roman Catholic Church. Poland is one of the most religious countries in Europe, where Roman Catholicism remains a criterion of national identity. Freedom of religion in Poland is guaranteed by the Constitution.
